To facilitate savings for costs associated with Step 3 of the United States Medical Licensing Exam ("USMLE"), McGaw is offering a savings program to all interested housestaff. Participants may elect to have up to \$50° per stipend check withheld for up to a two-year period. The money will be deducted from the housestaff's stipend check after taxes and maintained by McGaw in a non-interest bearing account. Housestaff may withdraw the full balance of the account by providing McGaw Payroll and Benefits with written notice at least seven business days before any stipend payment date. The requested amount will be included in the next stipend check. Housestaff may cancel this deduction at any time by notifying McGaw Payroll and Benefits in writing.

Alternatively, housestaff may elect to have a portion of their stipend deposited directly into his/her own savings or other account. To elect this procedure, please complete a Direct Deposit Authorization form, available from the McGaw benefits website.

This program is designed only to assist housestaff with saving for Step 3 of the USMLE. All paperwork associated with registering and paying for the exam is the responsibility of the housestaff member.

Stipend Deduction Authorization
